If you have not set up a mandate, please make your cheque payable to the “Welsh Railways Research Circle” (in full) & send it to me. If you are uncertain, or would like to renew by Standing Order, or believe you have credit towards your membership - please contact me for details. The Member’s Section of the Web site will also show anyone having credit.

The Welsh Railways Research Circle (WRRC) will store and handle your personal information in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).
