

Bryn Oer Tramway

Research notes

The Bryn Oer Tramway (also known as the Brinore Tramroad) was a horse-worked narrow gauge plateway built in 1814 taking the output from collieries and quarries near Trefil to Talybont on Usk. The papers consist of two folders:

Folder One - field work notes recorded from a walk along the route pointing out surviving features. Includes sketch maps and a draft of an article for the RCHS. Also notes from Brecon Library that includes tracings of tithe maps.

Folder Two - article entitled "Occasional Paper No.12 Tramroad Group Buildings Associated with the Brinore Tramroad" (2 copies). Also correspondence, notes and eight photographs taken during a walk of the route, plus an OS map.

Listed by Tony Miller, these papers are stored in the Circle's Archive room.
